BUSINESS MEETING MINUTES MARCH 21, 2018 (REVISED)

He also said that on Saturday April 28th in conjunction with the National Day of Prayer we would pray in front of the Planned Parenthood abortion clinic at 11 AM. Also, on the 28th is the Care Net Golf tournament. Lastly, there is a Senate Bill that uses tax payer's money to insist that all public colleges in California supply students with birth control pills trying to get passed

through, we are urged to make phone calls to our Congress men and women. There will be a 2nd degree exemplification at La Purisima Council 3570 on April 14th and we will be hosting a 3rd degree here on Saturday April 21st. There was a request for sideliners.

To get her out for holidays, doctors appointments, etc. is a momentous and expensive task. Everyday I prayed for her mobility to improve so she may be able to get out and about more without a huge production of time, money and people. Marie (my mother in-law) taught grade school at St Mary's and St Louis de Montfort schools and was very involved in our parish before her health declined; she touched a lot of students and families lives. Not to long ago after the passing of a family friend, the children of the deceased (whom Marie had taught) contacted my Wife with a proposition..... They knew of Marie's situation and offered their late mothers wheelchair accessible van to us to be able to get Marie out and about and for family functions, at no charge. We were blown away at this generous gift and humbly agreed with the stipulation that we pay it forward, this is where you Brother Knights come in...

I am offering my services and wheel chair accessible van to pick up and transport Brother Knights (that may be confined to a wheelchair or have similar mobility issues) to K of C meetings, events or other functions that they may need assistance with. I do work full time during the day, however, I am available in the evenings (after 5pm) and on weekends. Please pass this around to those you may feel have a need of assistance.
